

## BMAC Membership Renewal 2020

To simplify the renewal process a single line signature sheet will be available at the Annual General Meeting and members signing this sheet will not have to complete the "Standard Renewal Form"

The preferred method of payment is by Bank Transfer, and Club account details are as follows:

**Basingstoke Model Aero Club. Sort Code 40-09-18, Account number 12011840.**

To identify the payee under payment reference, insert your BMFA number (no need for the S at the start of your number) and add your surname or as much as the space allows.

Payment does not have to be made at the AGM but your renewal will not be finalised until payment is made.

To continue flying from the 1<sup>st</sup> **January 2020** you need to have completed the renewal process.

To avoid paying the late re-joining fee, payment must be received by the 31<sup>st</sup> January.

Members wishing to join after 31st December **2020** will be treated as new members and should use the **NEW** member joining form. (Note : the full new member joining fee is applicable)

Please note that CAA registration is now a requirement for all BMAC members, and the simplest way to do this is to add the CAA registration fee of £9.00 to your BMAC/BMFA subscription when you renew.

This will work provided that:

- i). You are registered on the BMFA portal and they have your current E- Mail address.

If you are not registered on the portal, log on to the BMFA website and follow the instructions to register. Existing portal members can go to <https://bmfa.azolve.com> to check or amend their details. If you get stuck you can ring the BMFA admin number (01162 44 00 28) for help.

- ii) BMAC is your Primary club and you have a BMFA 'A' certificate or greater.

If you do not have an A cert, you will need to take the BMFA competency on-line test before renewal. To do this, go to [rcc.bmfa.uk](http://rcc.bmfa.uk) and click on the **Competency Test** link.

If you have already registered with CAA, you will need to provide me with your registration details.

You can expect to receive your Registration IDs from the CAA after the end of January.

The Club no longer issues BMAC membership cards but you will receive an email when the joining process is complete, with details of the new gate code which is valid from 1 January 2020.
